Dr. John Kampen holds the Dunn Chair in Biblical Interpretation at Methodist Theological School in Ohio. An eminent scholar of the Dead Sea Scrolls, the New Testament and Jewish history, Kampen is published widely on subjects as diverse as the Gospel of Matthew, anti-Semitism and African-American use of the Bible.

Dr. Kampen holds a B.A. from the University of Saskatchewan, a Master of Divinity degree from Mennonite Biblical Seminary, and a Ph.D. from Hebrew Union College – Jewish Institute of Religion.
