ALUM ASSOCIATION CONSTITUTION
(Revised 6/24/07)

Purpose

The purpose of the Methesco Alum Association is to foster the relationship of Methesco alums with each other and with the School.

Article I – Membership in the Alum Association

All alums shall be considered members of the Association. Methodist Theological School in Ohio defines alumni as one who has attended or graduated from MTSO in any of the School's degree programs, certificate programs, non-degree programs or alumni/ae who has audited coursework offered by the school.

Article II – The Alum Council

The Methesco Alum Council shall have the responsibility and authority to direct the business of the Alum Association. This includes planning and promotion of alum events, and acting as the Association's liaison with the School.

Article III – Composition of the Alumni Council

The Alum Council shall be composed of no more than 15 members; each elected for three-year terms, with five to be elected each year. No less than three-fourths (11) of the Alum Council shall consist of degreed Alumni/ae.

Article IV – Election of the Alum Council

The election of members to the Alum Council shall occur at a designated meeting, which shall be publicized through a general mailing to all alums. Persons shall be nominated by the nominating committee and/or from the floor.

No one shall be eligible to serve more than one full consecutive three-year term on the Alum Council. Terms of offices begin and end with the Annual Meeting of the Alumni Association. Alumni may serve more than one term as long as they are not consecutive.

Article V – Officers of the Alum Council

The Alum Council shall elect annually the following officers: Chairperson, Vice-Chairperson, and Secretary. The Vice-Chairperson shall have the authority to convene and conduct meetings of the Alum Council if the Chairperson is unable to perform his/her duties.

Article VI – Committees of the Alum Council

Nominating Committee – The members of the Alum Council whose terms are expiring shall serve as the nominating committee.

The Chairperson shall be empowered to appoint other committees as deemed necessary by the Alum Council.

Article VII – Amendments

This constitution can be amended by a two-thirds majority vote of alums present at a designated meeting.

Alternatively, amendments proposed by the Alum Council shall be effective if they receive a two-thirds majority vote of alums responding on ballots, which have been mailed, to all alums.
