M.Div. Course Frequency

The following information is to be used for planning purposes for the M.Div. Degree. The best advice is to take your required courses first and save your electives for the end of your final year. Also, pay attention to prerequisites when you are planning.

Please note that this list is not a guarantee, as occasionally the course schedule has to be altered due to faculty availability or other extenuating circumstances.

HB-110	Intro Hebrew Bible	Usually every Fall and Spring; alternating summers, occasionally J-term	None
NT-110	Intro New Testament	Usually every Fall and Spring; alternating summers, occasionally J-term	None
HB/NT-2XX	200-level HB or NT course	Usually every Fall and Spring	HB-110 & NT-110
HB-3XX	300-level exegesis course	Usually every Fall and Spring	HB-2XX or NT-2XX
NT-3XX	300-level exegesis course	Usually every Fall and Spring	HB-2XX or NT-2XX
CH-125	Church History I	Usually every Fall and Spring	None
CH-235	Church History II	Usually every Spring	CH-125
CH-3XX	300-level Church History course	Usually every Fall and Spring	CH-235
CT-149	Intro to Theology	Usually every Fall and Spring	None
CT-2XX	200-level Theology course	Usually every Fall and Spring	CT-149
CE-101	Intro to Christian Ethics	Usually every Fall and Spring	None, but it is recommended to take CT-149 prior to CE-101

CT/CE 2XX/3XX	200 or 300-level CT or CE course	Usually every Fall and Spring	Prerequisite depends on course choice
CR-201	Cross Cultural Pre-Immersion	Usually every Fall and Spring	None (usually taken 2nd year)
CR-202	Cross Cultural Immersion Trip	Usually every January and Summer	CR-201
CR-203	Cross Cultural Post-Immersion	Usually every Fall and Spring	CR-202
PC-100	Foundations for Pastoral Care	Usually every Fall and Spring	None
PT-100	Leadership, Learning & Community	Usually every Fall and Spring	None
<i>PT-100 replaces the CL100 & ED145 requirements for the MDIV and the ED145 requirement for the MACE. Students who have already taken ED145 OR CL100 should NOT take this class. See the registrar for more information.</i>			
WM-100	Intro Worship & Music	Usually every Fall and Spring; alternate summers and J-terms	None
HM-300	Intro to Homiletics	Usually every Fall, Spring and Summer	HB-110, NT-110, and CT-149
HM-400	400-level Homiletics course	Usually every Fall, Spring and Summer	HM-300
FE-475 a/b	Field Education	Every year (full year required; begins in Fall semester)	Must have completed 1/3 of M.Div. requirements, including at least one course in Theology and one course in Bible.
