If you choose an article or blog post as one of your resources, please ensure that the author is an expert. For example, you might choose an author associated with an unbiased and well-respected news outlet, publisher or periodical (Westminster John Knox Press, BBC, Wall Street Journal etc.); an accredited academic institution; or a well-established organization (an international non-governmental organization, a worldwide denomination etc.).
