- Our housing facilities have limited capacity. Applying for housing does not guarantee that housing will be assigned, or that the preferred housing assignment can be offered. Apartments in Helen Werner Apartment Building and Kleist Manor are unfurnished.
- MTSO is a smoke-free environment. Smoking is prohibited in all buildings on the MTSO campus, including campus housing units.
- To inquire about bringing a pet to campus, please contact us at housing@mtso.edu or 740-362-3333. There is limited availability of pet-friendly units, and all pet owners must abide by the school's pet policy. The pet deposit is \$500.
- Housing charges include all utilities, cable television, waste removal, local telephone service, access to free laundry facilities and dedicated high-speed internet service.
- The number of on-campus housing options for persons with physical disabilities is limited, but such requests will be given every consideration.
- MTSO is a weapons-free campus. Firearms of any kind are prohibited on campus regardless of whether an individual has a permit to carry the firearm.
- MTSO does not insure contents of any campus apartment or resident's personal property. Campus residents are
 urged to obtain renter's insurance for replacement value of your personal belongings.
- Water beds are not permitted in campus housing units.
- Open flames are generally prohibited in all campus areas.
- A Student Handbook with complete housing rules and regulations will be provided once housing is assigned.

Dewire Residence Hall

Please note that Dewire Residence Hall has a special early application deadline of Aug. 7, 2020.

Residence hall rooms are appropriate for commuting students. All Dewire Residence Hall rooms are single-occupancy and are fully furnished. Full size beds, linens and towels are included. During fall and spring semesters, room charges are billed to your student account and payable at the beginning of each semester. Housing fees do not include break/reading weeks. Meals are not included in the costs quoted below.

Special Dewire Residence Hall COVID-19 notice

To ensure physical distancing during the pandemic, Dewire Residence Hall has only 16 rooms available – each with a private (non-shared) bathroom. In the event of a shortage of rooms, preference will generally be given to those students who live farthest from the MTSO campus. Helen Werner Apartment Building

Helen Werner Apartment Building units are appropriate for single living. Apartment units are **unfurnished**. Couples or single parents with dependent children on campus are **not** assigned to this building. Semester rates are charged at the beginning of August and January. The months of January, June, July and August are not part of semester rates and are charged separately at the beginning of those months.

Helen Werner Apartment rooms may also be used for nightly stays, as space is available, for \$75 per night.

Kleist Manor Apartments

Couples and single parents with dependent children who live with or frequently visit their parents receive priority consideration for assignments in Kleist Manor Apartments. As space is available, a student without dependent children may rent a one-bedroom apartment, or two students may share a two-bedroom apartment. These apartments are **unfurnished**. Semester rates are charged at the beginning of August and January. The months of January, June, July and August are not part of semester rates and are charged separately at the beginning of those months.

Kleist deposits: \$300 damage + \$25 per key

Kleist Manor Apartments may also be used for nightly stays, as space is available, for \$95 per night.
