Please Note:

- **Our housing facilities have limited capacity. Applying for housing does not guarantee that housing will be assigned, or that the preferred housing assignment can be offered.**
- Apartments in the Helen Werner Apartment Building and Kleist Manor are unfurnished.
- MTSO is a smoke-free environment. Smoking is prohibited in all buildings on the MTSO campus, including campus housing units.
- All campus residents over the age of 5 are required to provide proof they are fully vaccinated against COVID-19, including up-to-date booster status.
- MTSO has a limited number of pet-friendly units, all in Kleist Manor. Those are the only housing units where pets are permitted to live. To inquire about bringing a pet to campus, please contact housing@mtso.edu or 740-362-3333. All pet owners must abide by the school's pet policy, which requires proof of pet insurance, current vaccination certificate and license when applicable. The pet fee is \$500.
- Housing charges include all utilities, cable television, waste removal, local telephone service, access to free laundry facilities and dedicated high-speed internet service.
- The number of on-campus housing options for persons with physical disabilities is limited, but such requests will be given every consideration. Please email requests to housing@mtso.edu.
- MTSO is a weapons-free campus. Firearms of any kind are prohibited on campus regardless of whether an individual has a permit to carry the firearm.
- MTSO does not insure contents of any campus apartment or resident's personal property. Campus residents are urged to obtain renter's insurance for replacement value of your personal belongings.
- Waterbeds are not permitted in campus housing units.
- Open flames are generally prohibited in all campus areas.

Dewire Residence Hall

Residence hall rooms are appropriate for commuting students. All Dewire Residence Hall rooms are single-occupancy and are fully furnished. Full-size beds, linens and towels are included. During fall and spring semesters, room charges are billed to your student account and payable at the beginning of each semester. Housing fees do not include break/reading weeks. Meals are not included in the costs quoted below. Dewire has a shared kitchen for residents' use on the lower level.

Helen Werner Apartment Building

Helen Werner Apartment Building units are appropriate for single living. Apartment units are unfurnished. Couples or single parents with dependent children on campus aren't assigned to this building. Semester rates are charged at the beginning of August and January. The months of January, July and August are not part of semester rates and are charged separately at the beginning of those months.

Kleist Manor Apartments

Couples and single parents with dependent children who live with or frequently visit their parents receive priority consideration for assignments in Kleist Manor Apartments. As space is available, a student without dependent children may rent a one-bedroom apartment, or two students may share a two-bedroom apartment. These apartments are unfurnished. Semester rates are charged at the beginning of August and January. The months of January, July and August are not part of semester rates and are charged separately at the beginning of those months.
