**Dr. Jeffrey Jaynes**, the Warner Professor of Church History at Methodist Theological School in Ohio, conducted research for this lecture in fall 2014 as the Cameron Faculty Fellow at the University of St Andrews Reformation Studies Institute in Scotland and in spring 2015 as a research fellow at the Herzog August Bibliothek, Wolfenbüttel, Germany. The lecture is part of a larger book project, *From Luther to Lutheranism: Architects of Church Order in 16th Century Northern Germany*.

Dr. Jaynes also is the author of *Christianity Beyond Christendom: The 'Global' Christian Experience on Medieval and Early Modern World Maps*, to be published in 2016 by Harrassowitz Verlag of Wiesbaden, Germany. An ordained minister in the Presbyterian Church (USA), he holds a doctorate from Ohio State University, a Master of Divinity degree from Fuller Theological Seminary and a bachelor's from California State University, Fresno.
