His areas of expertise include the spiritual and vocational aspirations of youth and young adults, including youth cultures; popular culture; spiritual practices; ecology; justice and peace movements; communal movements; and alternative forms of church. He is the author of *Created in Delight: Youth Ministry and the Mending of the World*, published by Wipf and Stock in 2013.

Dr. Van Meter holds a B.S. from Tennessee Technological University; a Master of Divinity degree from Emory University, Candler School of Theology; and a Ph.D. from Emory University's Graduate School of Arts and Sciences, Graduate Division of Religion.
