Dr. Raymond F. Person Jr. is a professor of religion in the Department of Religion and Philosophy at Ohio Northern University. He lives on a historic Swiss Mennonite homestead near Bluffton, run by a cooperative of 17 families to produce meat, eggs and vegetables.

The author of eight books, Dr. Person holds a bachelor's degree from Phillips University, a master's from the Graduate Seminary at Phillips University and a doctorate from Duke University.
