Part II: Alford-Cantlin Fellows Cohort | Plan of Study

Start Date: Summer 2022; The program plans to welcome a new cohort every other year.

Location: On site and online via Methodist Theological School in Ohio and WOC Center, Worthington, OH

<u>Goal</u>: The goal of the program is to increase effectiveness among West Ohio Conference clergy by encouraging the pursuit of advanced professional development that includes evidenced-based program supports and enhancements.

<u>Program:</u> Clergy who are serving in the WOC will complete their DMin program at MTSO in a peer cohort of other WOC clergy. Known as Alford-Cantlin Fellows, participants will receive additional supports from WOC beyond those provided by their academic program at MTSO including:

- peer and family support;
- one-on-one clergy mentoring;
- lay mentorship;
- mental health/wellness supports;
- and scholarship funding.

<u>Eligibility</u>: Ordained clergy serving in appointments in the West Ohio Conference who have completed the REF process and who meet the criteria for admission to the MTSO DMin program and meet all application deadlines are eligible to apply. Ordained United Methodist clergy of all ages and backgrounds who meet these criteria may apply, and diverse candidates are encouraged to apply.

<u>Scholarships and Aid</u>: WOC and MTSO will work with each potential cohort participant to determine what financial aid they may qualify for including local church funding, MEF funds, aid from MTSO if available, personal contribution, or outside grants after which they can apply for last-dollar support up to half the cost of the program from the Alford Endowment and/or Frazer Excellence in Ministry Scholarship of the United Methodist Foundation of West Ohio. It's important that applicants seek all potential sources of support and provide documentation about their search.
