Since 2005, **Dr. Jacqui Lewis** has led Middle Collegiate Church, which describes itself as “a multicultural, multiethnic, intergenerational movement of Spirit and justice, powered by fierce, revolutionary Love, with room for all.”

Books she has authored include *Ten Essential Strategies for Becoming a Multiracial Congregation* and *The Just Love Story Bible*.
